Project vision & mission

To restore education and learning opportunities to the 6.7 million children between the ages of 3–18. To ensure the tools and supplies necessary are available to all the children of Ukraine. Every child would be out of harm's way in a perfect world. Students would have a safe place, bunker, subway station, or another country to study.

"According to the latest survey data, up to 57 percent of teachers report a deterioration in students' Ukrainian language abilities, up to 45 percent report a reduction in mathematics skills, and up to 52 percent report a reduction in foreign language abilities." – UNICEF

Chkalvosky Lyceum

From March 03, 2022, until September 07, 2022, Chkalvosky and the surrounding area was occupied. During this time 5 of the 6 schools in the region were destroyed. These schools served over 1000 students in the area. Chkalvosky was home to 532 students. Currently 308+ reside in the village and are eager to return to class. The school has a bunker that needs repairs to create a safe space to continue education.

Only 67 km by car to the front lines of the conflict, since liberation.

The Bunker

Built in the early 1980 as a part of U.S.S.R.'s nuclear program, it has been left unused and in disarray since. Some previous students (now adults), teachers and community members were excited to hear about our willingness to restore the bunker. They organized themselves and began cleaning and preparing for our team to conduct renovations and repairs.
